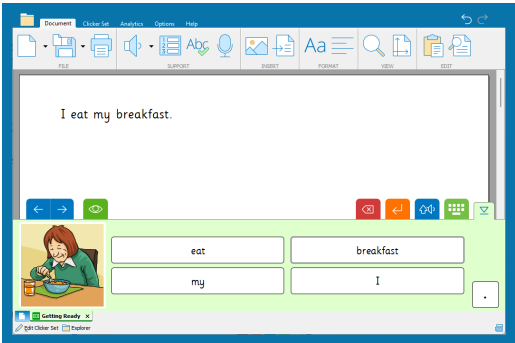

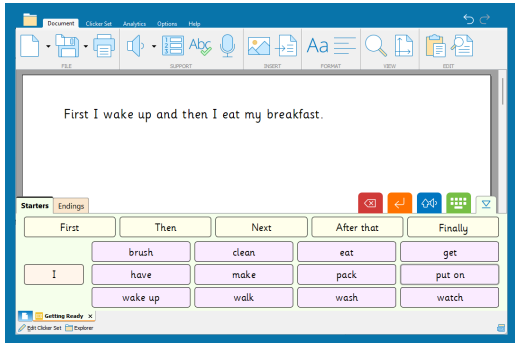

Sentence Sets

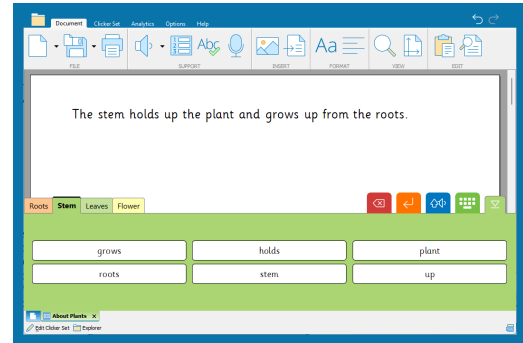

Connect Sets

Connect Sets are ideal for supporting your developing writers, providing students with clusters of words to help them build a coherent piece of text. It is still scaffolded writing but gives a greater choice of words and phrases.



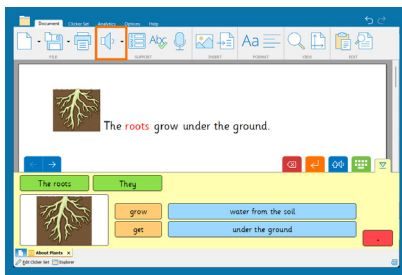
Word Banks

Word Banks give students access to correctly spelled subject-specific vocabulary and provides support to more independent writers when using new or challenging vocabulary. The student will type most of their sentence, using the Word Bank to access key vocabulary.

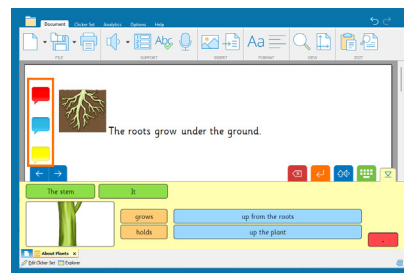
CLICKER'S SUPPORTIVE WORD PROCESSOR

All of Clicker's Support Tools can be used alongside any writing grid.



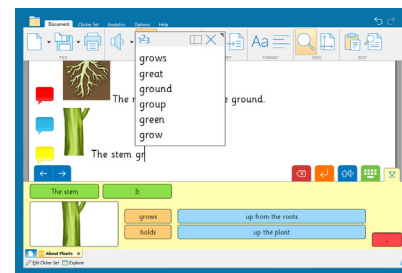
Speech feedback

Clicker's [speech feedback](#) encourages learners to proofread their work and identify errors that might have been missed. When end punctuation is added to a sentence, Clicker will read it.



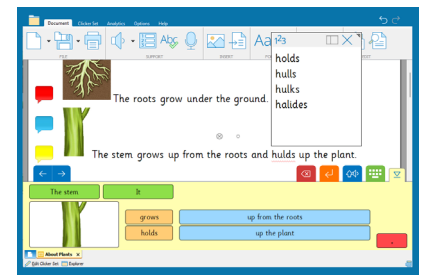
Voice Notes

[Voice Notes](#) enable students to record their own audio notes before they write. They can rehearse their sentences and capture their initial thoughts and ideas.



Predictor

The [Predictor](#) suggests words based on the context of the student's writing; it helps to keep the student's writing momentum moving forward and is great for those who struggle to get started. The Predictor provides options even when words are misspelled and will include words from open resources in Clicker.



Spell Check Tool

Our talking [Spell Check](#) is a fantastic tool to help students identify spelling mistakes independently and gives them the opportunity to correct them before completing their work.
