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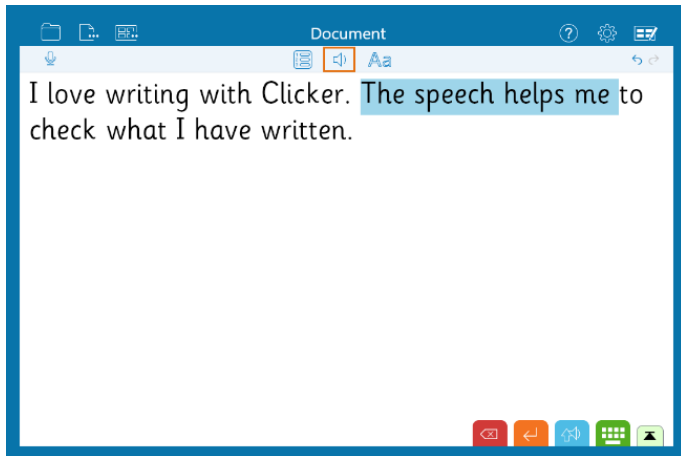

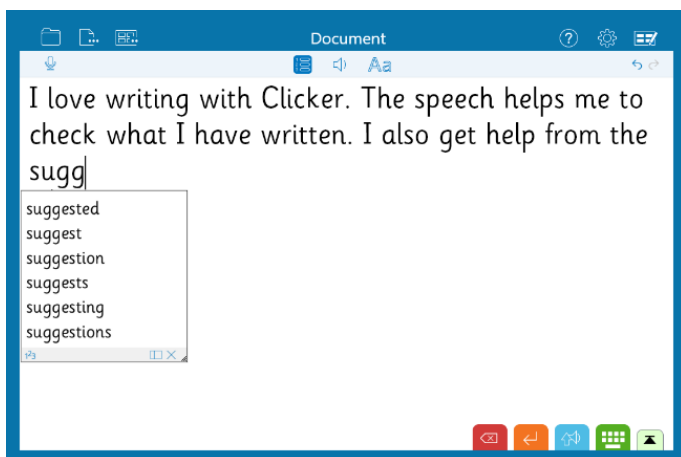
Get Started



Speech

The speech function allows children to hear what they've written:

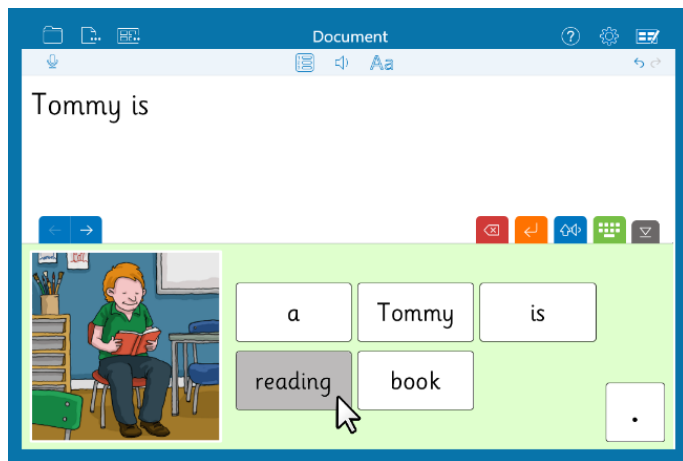
- Enter a full stop to hear your sentence.
- Highlight text then select  to hear it.
- Click or tap a word in the document to hear it.



Predictor

The Predictor offers vocabulary to improve writing fluency and provide spelling support:

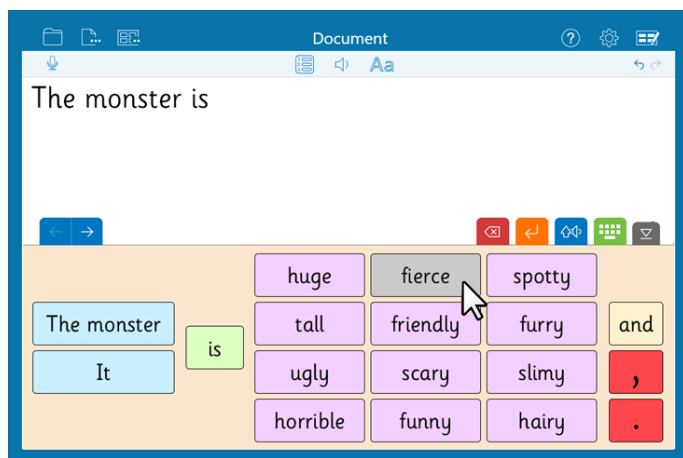
- Select  to start using the Predictor.
- Choose a word in the Predictor to use it.
- Select  then a word in the Predictor to hear it or right-click it.



Sentence Sets

A Sentence Set is a series of grids for writing simple sentences:

- Select a word in the Sentence Set to add it to your document.
- Use the forward arrow or swipe forward to move to the next sentence.



Connect Sets

A Connect Set provides more open-ended activities. This allows children to create a more individual piece of writing with plenty of support:

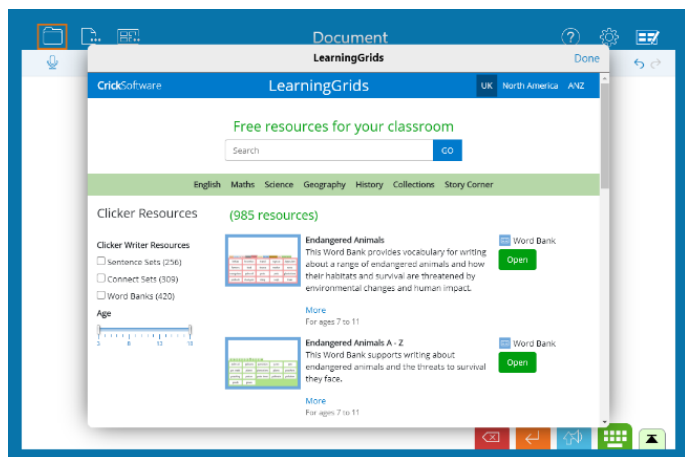
- Select a word in the Connect Set to add it to your document.
- Use the forward arrow or tabs to move to the next grid.



Word Banks

A Word Bank provides alphabetical or topic-based word lists to use alongside the keyboard to write about any subject:

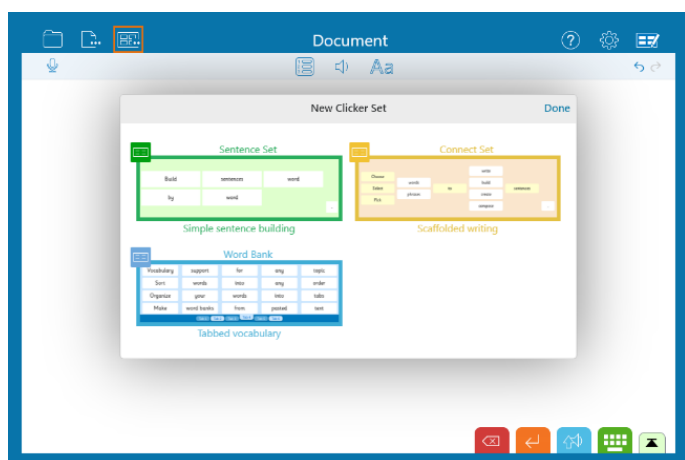
- Select a word in the Word Bank to add it to your document.
- Use SoundShift or right-click a word or phrase in the Word Bank to hear it.
- Use the tabs to move between grids.



LearningGrids

LearningGrids is an ever-expanding bank of free pre-made Clicker resources to save you planning time:

- Select  to open the Explorer then choose LearningGrids.

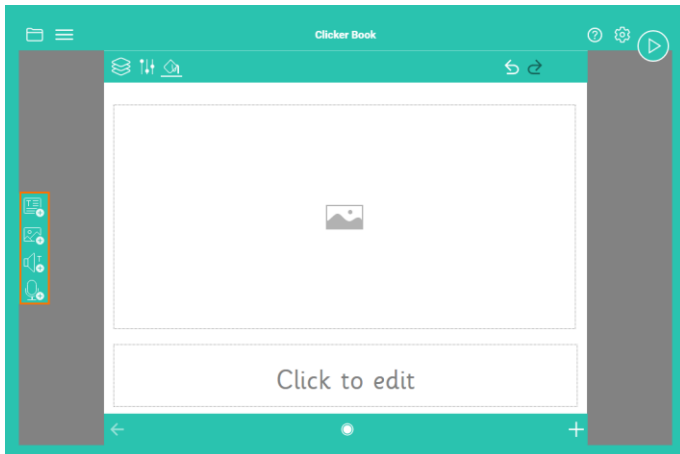

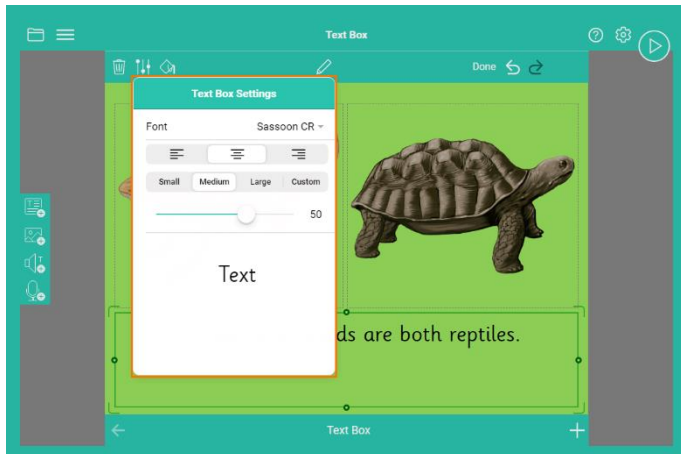
- Select  to add a text box. Select the text box to add text.
- Select  to add a picture box. Select the picture box, then choose from the options to add an image.
- Select  to add a read button.
- Select  to add a record & play button.

- Select  to use the Clicker Book.

Edit a Clicker Book

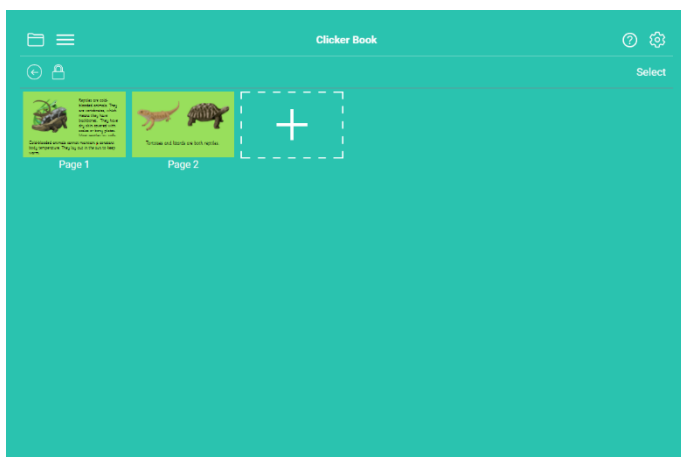
Edit a Clicker Book to change the properties:

- Select a Page Object to edit it:



- Resize a Page Object by dragging the sides or corners.
- Drag from the centre of the Page Object to reposition it.
- Use  to edit its properties.
- Use  to change its colours. If no Page Object is selected,  changes the background colour of the page.
- Use  to delete a Page Object.

- Go to  to add a new page.
- Go to  to open the Page Sorter:

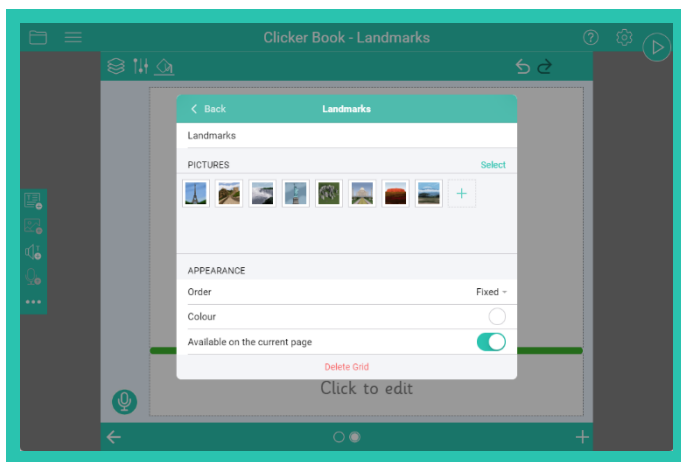


- Drag pages to rearrange your book.
- Select  to add a new page.
- Choose 'Select' to change page settings.
- Go to  to duplicate a page.
- Go to  to delete a page.
- Go to  to change page layout and lock Page Objects.
- Select 'Done' when you've finished making changes.
- Select a page to open it for further editing.

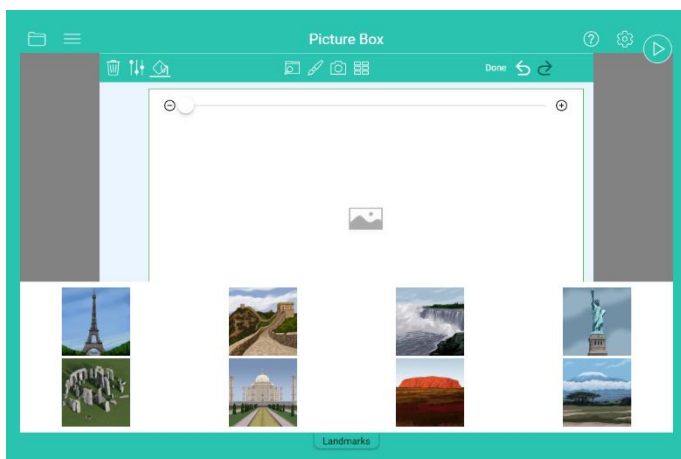
Add a Picture Bank to a Clicker Book

Add pictures for children to choose from when creating a Clicker Book:



- Go to  with nothing on the page selected:

- Go to the Picture Boxes tab and select  to add a Picture Bank.
- Give your Picture Bank a name.
- Select  to choose images for your Picture Bank from images saved on your device or the CrickPix2 library.
- Toggle Available on the current page on, then go back.
- Repeat to add multiple Picture Banks.

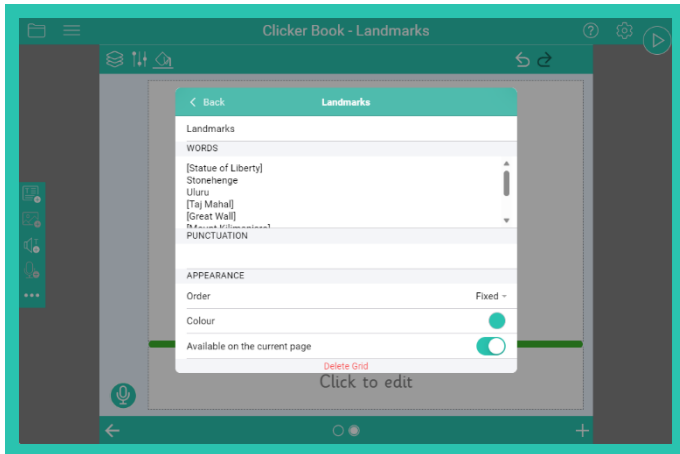

Add a Word Bank to a Clicker Book

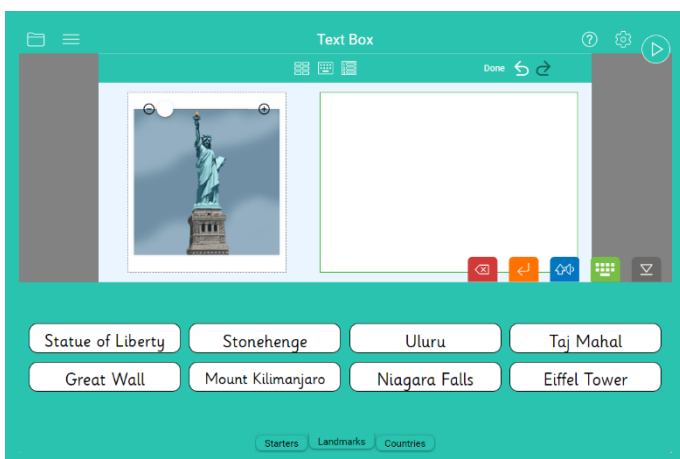
Add words and phrases for children to use when writing in their Clicker Book:



- Go to  with nothing on the page selected:

- Go to the Text Boxes tab and select  to add a Word Bank.
- Give your Word Bank a name.
- Type or paste text into the Words text box to make up your Word Bank.
- Toggle Available on the current page on, then go back.
- Repeat to add multiple Word Banks.

- Toggle Show Word Bank immediately on for the Word Bank to appear when you start writing in a text box.
- Drag the grids to change the order of multiple Word Banks.

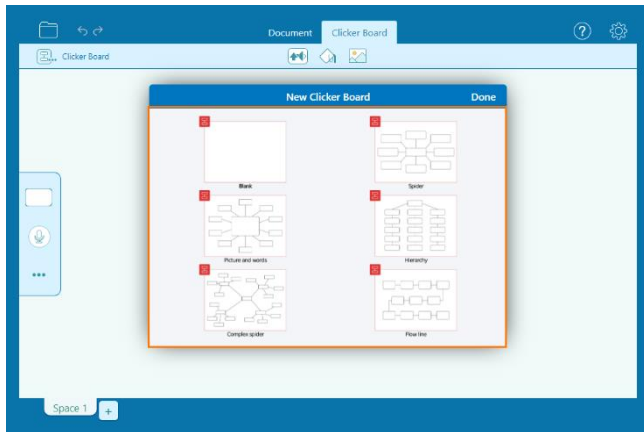

- Select a word or phrase to add it to the text box.

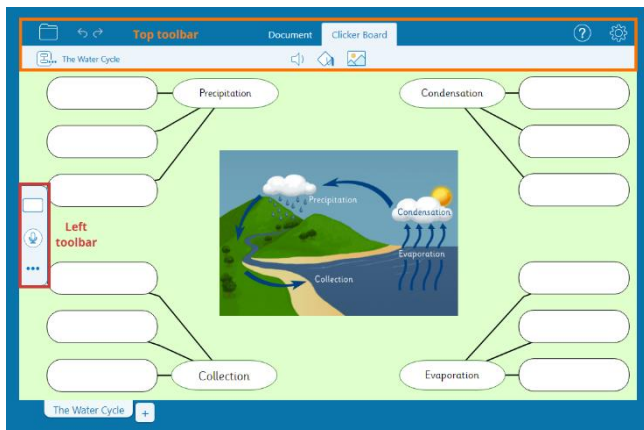
Create a Clicker Board

Use a Clicker Board to help children plan and develop ideas before writing:



- Select the Clicker Board tab in Clicker Writer.
- Select  in the top toolbar, then choose new Clicker Board.
- Choose a template to get started.
- There are different ways to add a cell to your Board:

- Drag  on to the Board.
- Double-click on the Board.
- Drag from the round handles highlighting a previously placed cell to create a new cell linked to the first.
- Drag  on to the Board to add a Voice Note. Select  in the top toolbar to make a recording.



- Double-click a cell to add text.
 - Link two cells by dragging from the round handle on to the other cell.
 - Select  to add a new page to the board.
- Move between the tabs to create or access more content.
 - Double-click a tab to rename it.

- Send your mind map to the Document to support writing in different ways.

- Go to .
- Choose Send to Document to send your mind map to the Document as a diagram or text.
- Select Create Word Bank to turn your Clicker Board into a Word Bank.

Edit a Clicker Board

Edit a Clicker Board to organise ideas more clearly:

- Drag the square handles to re-size a cell.
- In the left toolbar:

- Go to  with a cell selected, then choose a new shape for the cell.

- In the top toolbar:

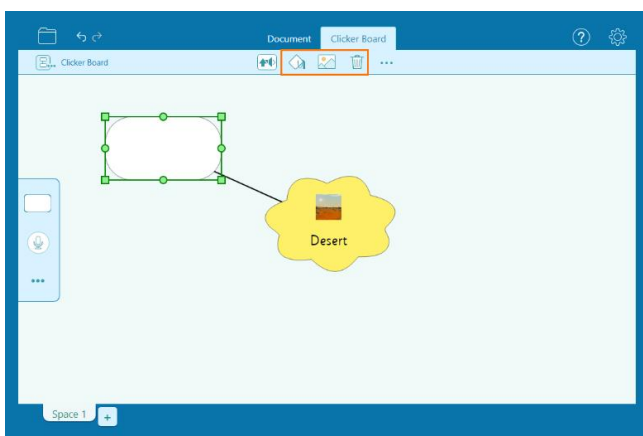
- Go to  with a cell selected to add a picture to the cell.

- Choose from images in the CrickPix2 library, images saved on your device or take a photo with your webcam.

- Go to  with a cell selected to change the colour of the cell.

- Select multiple cells to change their appearance or move them at the same time. To do this:

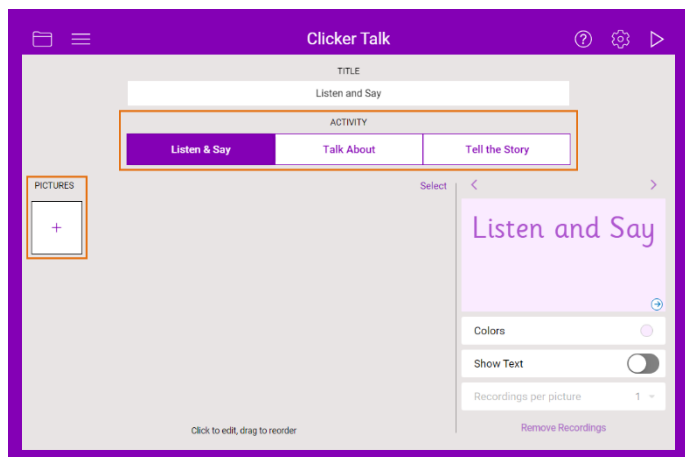
- On a Chromebook, click cells while holding Ctrl.
- On an iPad, tap Select in the lower toolbar, tap cells to select them, then tap Select again.

Create a Talk Set

Create an activity to support children who struggle to express themselves in written form:



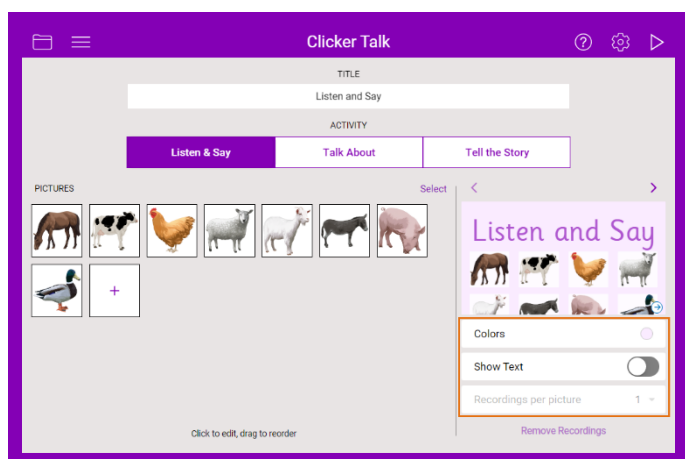
- Open the toolbar. Select  and choose new Talk Set.
- Give your activity a title.
- Pick which type of activity you want to create: Listen & Say, Talk About, or Tell the Story.
- Go to  and choose where you'd like to search for pictures to add to your activity:

○ Select the pictures you want to use and then click Done.

- Select  to use the Talk Set.

Edit a Talk Set

Edit a Talk Set to provide support or challenge for learners:



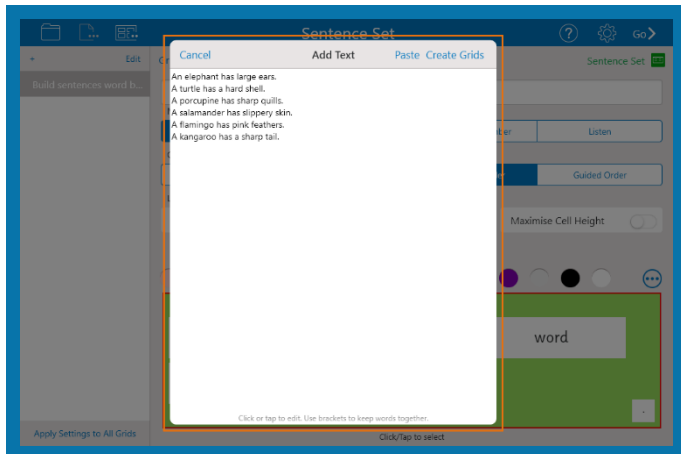
- Open the toolbar. Select  to enter Edit View.
- Use the Show Text toggle to add the name of the picture to the activity.
- Choose from the Recordings per picture drop-down box to change the number of recordings you can make for each picture.
- Choose a colour from the Colours options to change the colour of the pages.
- Choose from the options to change the type of activity: Listen & Say, Talk About, or Tell the Story.

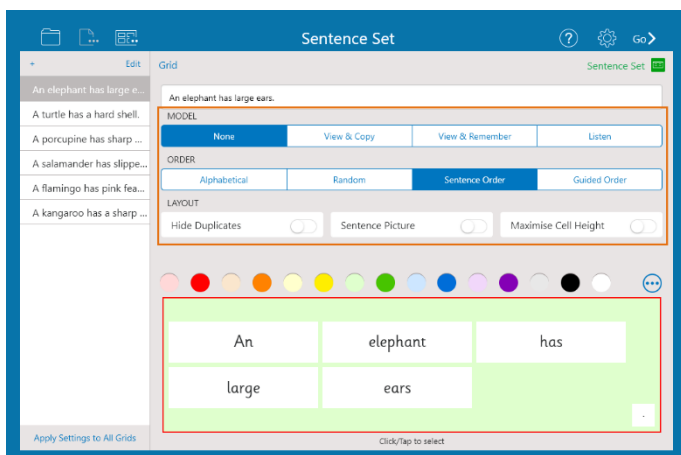

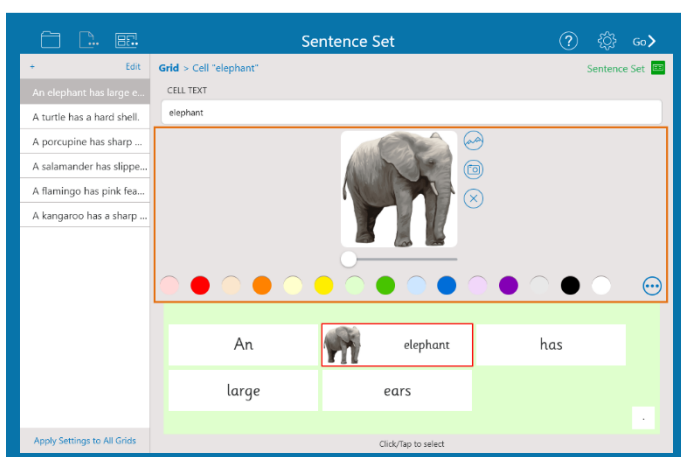

- Click  then type or paste sentences into the text box to make up your Sentence Set. Click Create Grids.
- Add brackets around words to group them in a cell.
- Click Go to use the Sentence Set.

Edit a Sentence Set

Edit a Sentence Set to provide different levels of support for children when completing their writing:



- Change the Model to provide different levels of writing support.
- Turn on Show Sentence Picture to add an image to the start of the sentence.
- Select from the Order options to change the order words appear in the grid.
- Select a cell to change its appearance or add a picture.
- Choose from the colour palette to change the colour of a grid.
- Click the Apply Settings to All Grids button to apply any changes you've made to all of the sentences in the set.

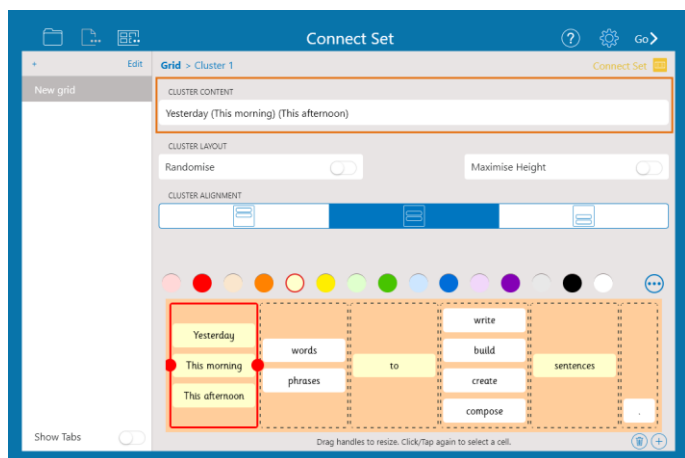

Create a Connect Set

Create grids to scaffold writing tasks for developing and struggling writers:

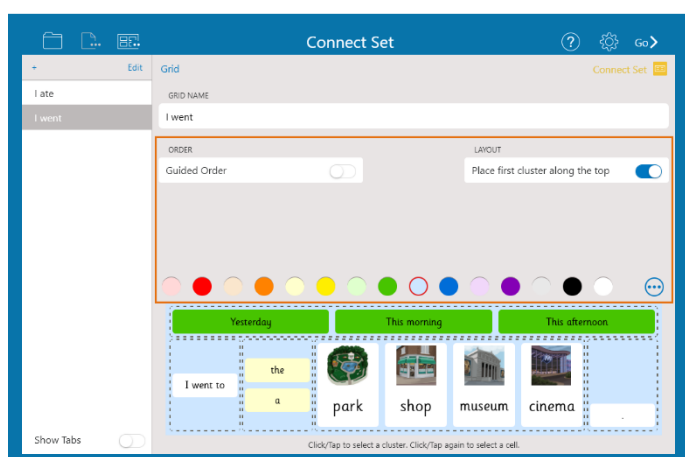
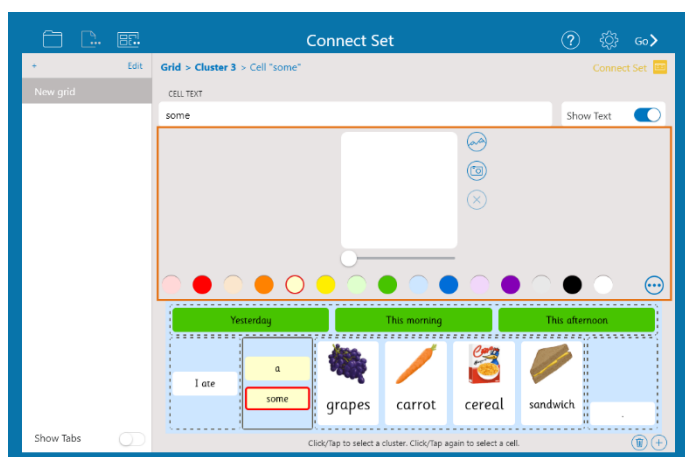
- Click  and select New Clicker Set.
- Choose Connect Set.
- Select a cluster and type in the content box to add text to your grid.
- Add brackets around words to group them in a cell.
- Click Go to use the Connect Set.



Edit a Connect Set

Edit a Connect Set to provide more support for children when completing their writing:

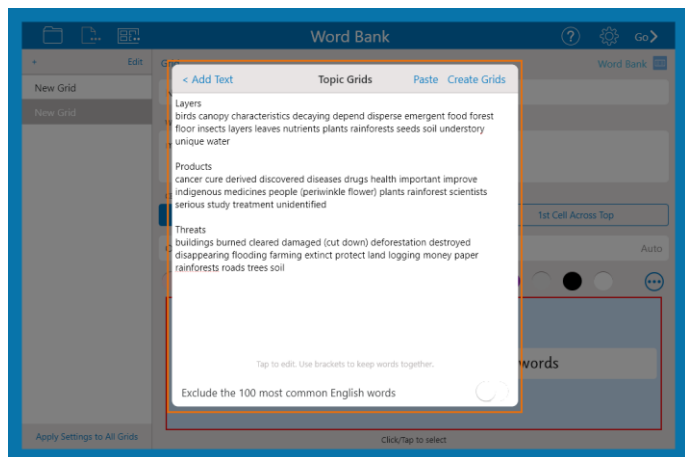
- Select a cell or a cluster to change its appearance.
- Click  to add a new cell or cluster.
- Click  to delete a cell or cluster.
- Click and drag the red handles to resize a cluster.
- Choose from the colour palette to change the colour of a grid.
- Turn on Maximise Height to increase the size of the cells in a cluster.
- Select Place first cluster along the top to move the first cluster of cells to the top of the grid.
- Click  to add a new grid to your set.



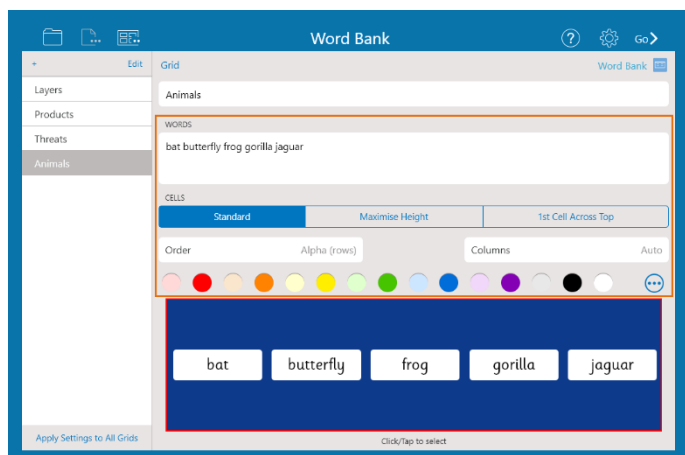

Create a Word Bank

Create grids to support children writing using more difficult vocabulary:



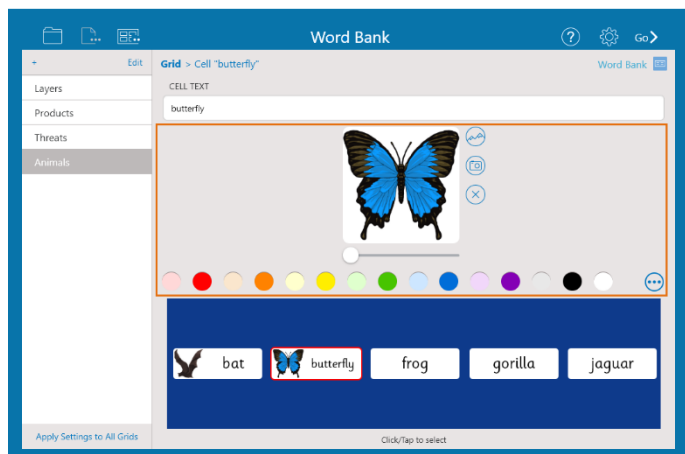
- Click  and select New Clicker Set.
- Choose Word Bank.
- Click  and select Add Multiple Grids, choose whether to sort the words into Topic grids or Alphabetic grids. Type or paste text into the text box to make up your Word Bank and choose whether to filter out most common English words. Click Create Grids to create your Word Bank.
- Add brackets around words to group them in a cell.
- Click Go to use the Word Bank.



Edit a Word Bank

Edit a Word Bank to provide different levels of support for children when completing their writing:

- Add or delete vocabulary offered in a grid by typing in the Words text box.
- Click the Order drop down box to change the order words appear in the grid.
- Select a cell to change its appearance or add a picture.
- Click  to create a new grid.
- Choose from the colour palette to change the colour of a grid.
- Click Edit then drag grids in the sidebar to reorder them.
- Click the Columns drop-down box to change the number of columns on a grid.



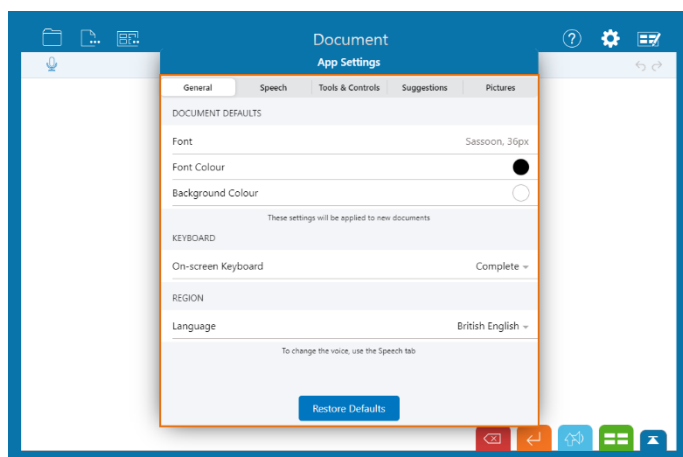

General

Adjust the General settings to change general Clicker Writer app settings:

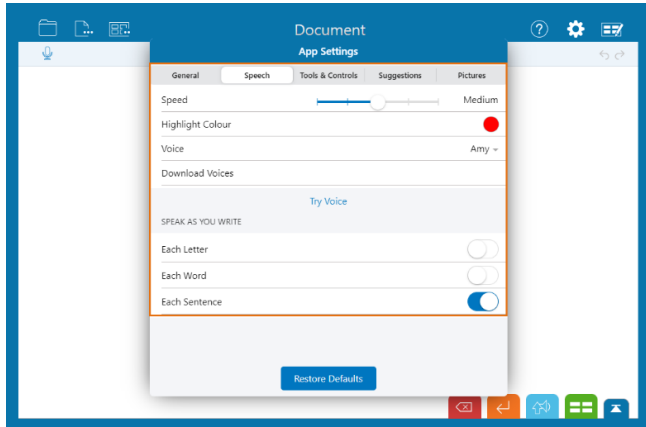
- Select  to open the App Settings. It will open the 'General' page:



- Select 'Font' to change the default font style and size. This will affect any new Document you create.
 - Select 'Font Colour' to change the default font colour in the document. This will affect any new Document you create.
 - Select 'Background Colour' to change the default background colour of the document. This will affect any new Document you create.
 - Select 'On-screen Keyboard' to change the layout of the on-screen keyboard.
 - Choose from the language settings for different regional options.
- Select 'Restore Defaults' at the bottom of the window at any point to Restore the default App Settings.
 - Select  formatting in the lower Toolbar to change text formatting options in the document you currently have open.

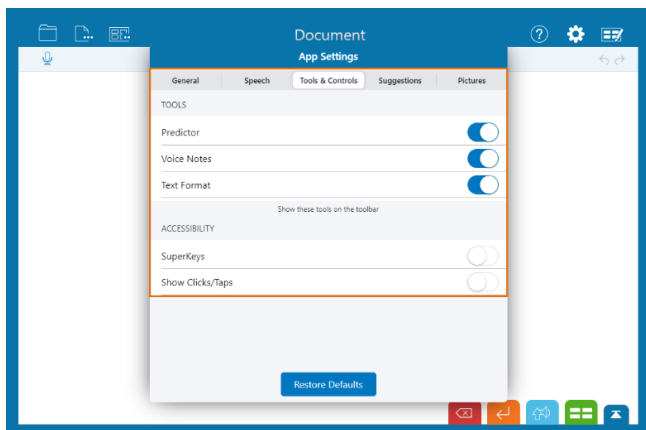
Adjust the speech settings to change the voice and when Clicker speaks:



- Select  and choose 'Speech':
 - Adjust the slider to change the speed of the voice.
 - Select 'Highlight Colour' to change how text is highlighted when it's read out.
 - Open the 'Voice' drop-down box to change the voice Clicker uses.
 - Select 'Download Voices' to download more voices to use. 'Try Voice' lets you hear a sample of the voice you currently have selected.
 - Use the 'Speak As You Write' switches to change when Clicker Speaks.

Tools & Controls

Adjust the Tools & Controls settings to change which tools are available and to improve accessibility:

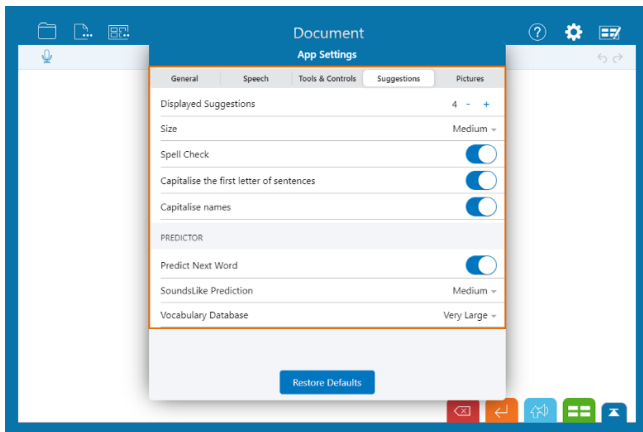


- Select  and choose 'Tools & Controls':
 - Use the 'Tools' switches to change which tools are offered to learners in the lower Toolbar. This changes whether learners can access the Predictor, Voice Notes, and text formatting options.
 - Use the 'Accessibility' switches to turn on SuperKeys and to choose whether clicks or taps are displayed on the screen.

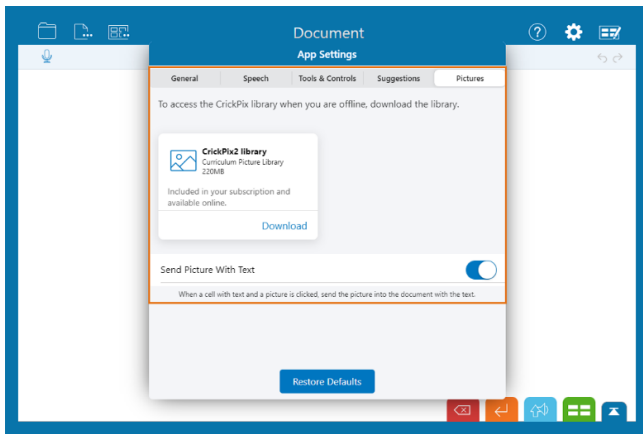
Suggestions

Adjust the Suggestions settings to change the level of support provided by the Predictor and Spell Check:

- Select  and choose 'Suggestions':



- Change the number of words offered by the Predictor and Spell Check.
- Use the 'Size' drop-down box to change the size the Predictor and Spell Check are displayed on the screen.
- Use the 'Spell Check' switch to choose whether Spell Check is turned on or off.
- Turn automatic capitalisation for first letters of sentences and names on or off with the switches.
- Use the 'Predict Next Word' switch to change whether the Predictor offers words before any letters are typed in the document.
- Use the SoundsLike Prediction drop-down box to change the priority given to phonetic spellings of words.
- Use the Vocabulary Database drop-down box to change the size of the database the Predictor uses for vocabulary.

Page Settings

- If not already in Edit View, go here  edit to open Edit View.
- Go to  to open the Page Settings window:

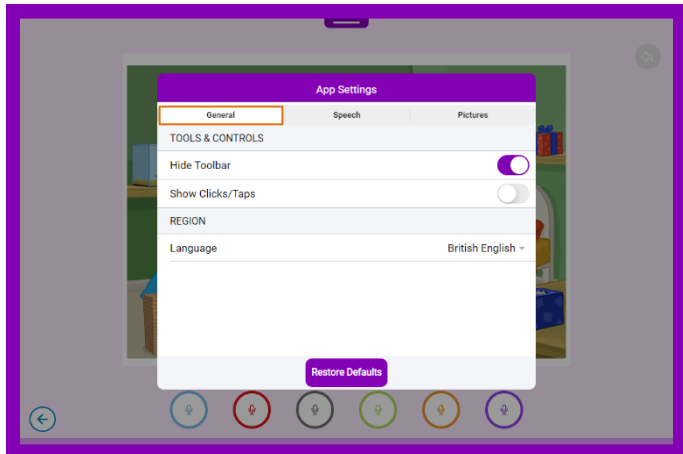


- Go to 'Layout' to change the page layout.
 - Go to 'Textboxes' to lock the textboxes Page Object.
 - Go to 'Picture Boxes' to lock the picture boxes Page Object and change the tools that are available for adding pictures to a page.
 - Go to 'Sound Boxes' to lock Read buttons and Record & Play buttons.
- When a Page Object is locked:
 - It cannot be edited.
 - No further instances of that Page Object can be added to the page.

Share via cloud storage



Once you have cloud storage installed on your devices, saving a file using one device will automatically sync it to the others. You'll need to [install the cloud provider's app](#) on your iPad and link the cloud app to the Apple Files app. Ask the person responsible for IT in your school to set this up.

- To share via cloud storage, choose the Save As option from the menu in any of the Clicker Apps.
- This will open the Files app. Navigate to your cloud folders using the options in the sidebar.

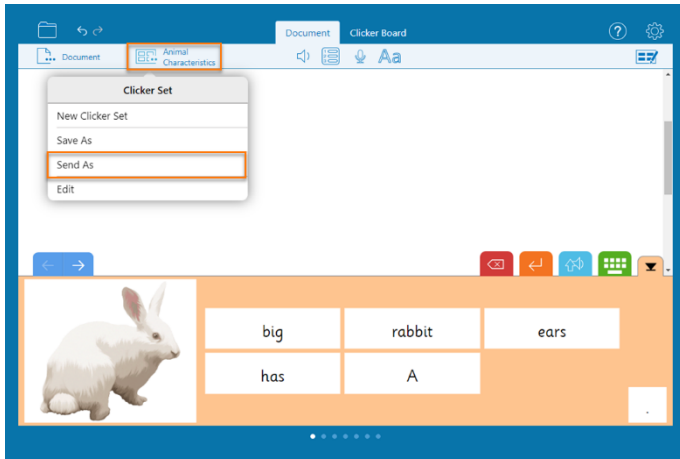

- Choose whether you want to attach a file from your cloud storage, or from your device.
- Select the file and then select **Share** or **Open**, this will upload a copy of your original file.
- If the file you want to share is available in your computer's file directory, you can just drag it to the message to share it.

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
